Application Requirements

School of Cross-Cultural Studies

Females without Japanese citizenship must fulfil all three conditions below.

1. You must be 18 years old or older as of 1 April, 2017.
2. Applicants must be qualified to obtain a “foreign student” visa in accordance with the provisions of the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act of Japan and possess a strong desire to study at our university. You must also:
 - ① have completed 12 years of school education abroad by 31 March 2017; or
 - ② have completed secondary education abroad and their Japanese university entrance preparation at school certified by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science & Technology (MEXT); or
 - ③ have completed their secondary education abroad (The applicants have completed more than 11 years of school education abroad or completed the school education in any institution which meets the standard set by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology(MEXT).) which the Ministry of Education, Culture,

Sports, Science and Technology(MEXT) approves.

- ④ have completed their International Baccalaureate (or equivalent) in the past 2 years.
3. You must have attained N1 (formerly 1kyu) or N2 (formerly 2kyu) in the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test administered by either the Japan Foundation or Japan Educational Exchanges and Services.

Notes

1. With respect to Section 2, Parts ② & ④, applicants who wish to undergo individual assessment of their eligibility, should inquire at the Sugiyama Admissions Office no later than 30 days before the start of the application period.
2. Due to differences in foreign education systems, applicants who are unsure of their ability to fulfil requirements should consult with the Sugiyama Admissions Office before applying.
3. Any falsification found in submitted applications may result in withdrawing a placement offer, even after enrolment.

School of Human Sciences/School of Culture-Information Studies

Females without Japanese citizenship must fulfil conditions 1 & 2 as well as either 3 or 4 below.

1. You must be 18 years old or older as of 1 April, 2017.
2. Applicants must be qualified to obtain a “foreign student” visa in accordance with the provisions of the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act of Japan and possess a strong desire to study at our university. You must also:
 - ① have completed 12 years of school education abroad by 31 March 2017; or
 - ② have completed secondary education abroad and their Japanese university entrance preparation at school certified by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science & Technology (MEXT); or
 - ③ have completed their secondary education abroad (The applicants have completed more than 11 years of school education abroad or completed the school education in any institution which meets the standard set by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology(MEXT).) which the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology(MEXT) approves.
 - ④ have completed their International Baccalaureate (or equivalent) in the past 2 years.

3. You must have attained N1 (formerly 1kyu) or N2 (formerly 2kyu) in the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test administered by either the Japan Foundation or Japan Educational Exchanges and Services.
4. Applicants at Japanese Language schools approved by the School/Department applied to must be regarded as having achieved a standard of Japanese language ability which enables them to understand classes in Japanese, or a level equivalent to those in 3 above.
